Planning & rates

The total cost to hold your wedding with us is \$10,000. In order to hold your date, a non-refundable deposit of \$5,000 is required at the time of booking to secure your preferred date.

Our wedding season runs from June through September. The first two weeks of June may or may not be ideal for outdoor ceremonies, depending on the level of snow melt.

Catering

Due to being closed during the summer months, access to our facility is limited.
