Planning & rates

The total cost of holding your wedding with us is \$12,000. To hold your preferred date, a non-refundable deposit of \$6,000 is required at the time of booking.

Our wedding season runs from June through September. The first two weeks of June may or may not be ideal for outdoor ceremonies, depending on the level of snowmelt.

Catering

Due to being closed during the summer months, access to our facility is limited. While we do not provide food services, we allow you to choose your own caterer and they would have the use of our kitchen for light food staging and preparation. The kitchen's ice machine, sinks, prep tables and refrigerators are available for your use.
